47th Meeting, 4 – 7 June 1985, Budapest, Hungary.

Technical Programme

Papers will be presented in three halls concurrently commencing on Tuesday 4 June 1985 after the official opening. Three further days are allocated to the technical programme which will finish at the end of the afternoon session on Friday 7 June 1985.

Papers should be relevant to prospecting for minerals and fossil fuels. The topics may range from theory to case histories. If too many papers are submitted for the total time available, one of the criteria used by the Programme Committee in The Hague will be whether the author(s) is a member of the Association.

Abstracts of papers intended for presentation at the meeting should be submitted *before 14 February 1985 to:*

Papers must be original, and must not have appeared in any other publication. Copyright will remain with the EAEG unless a release from this condition is obtained at the time of submission. Copyright will return to the author within six months if by that time he has not been informed that the EAEG intends to exercise the copyright.

The abstract should be in English, be less than 300 words and not contain any formulae. Abstracts should contain:

- (a) Title of the paper and name of the author(s);
- (b) Name of the person who will present the paper, *underlined*;
- (c) Full address of the author(s), at the bottom.

On a separate sheet, the author(s) should state:

- (d) Language in which the paper will be read;
- (e) Required visual aids;
- (f) Whether the author(s) is a member of the EAEG;
- (g) Whether the person who will present the paper will then be under the age of thirty.

5 x 5 cm slide projectors are available. In view of the size of the halls speakers are advised not to use overhead projecting.

Each selected paper will be allotted 25 minutes inclusive discussion. Times in the meeting programme will be meticulously observed.

The Programme Committee will notify the selected authors by 1 April 1985 and advise on presentation.

Copies of the final programme will be sent to all members of the EAEG and to the selected authors who are not members.
